



INFLATABLE SAFETY

Is reliant upon common sense, good supervision and the following

dos & don'ts

NO SHOES

NO FOOD

NO DRINK

NO CHEWING GUM

Before each play make sure mats are in place and supervisor is present

Remove sharp/hard objects from pockets and clothing (badge buckle etc.

We advise users to remove glasses

Ensure only users of the same age +size range use the inflatable at any one time

Adults are not allowed on children's inflatable's other than for assistance

Never inflate/deflate with users on the inflatable

No somersaults, Acrobatics etc. Stop any dangerous play immediately

Do not move or remove the inflatable

No climbing on the walls, beams towers or any part of the inflatable not designed for jumping /sliding on

NO PARTY POPPERS OR SILLY STRING- These leaves silly stains *

Prior to our collection

1. Clean away the mess /dirt with warm water and towel dry
2. Wipe away any face paint marks (baby wipes work well for this)
3. Please leave the inflated ready for our collection
4. Don't let anyone else collect the inflatable, identifiable billabong staff only

We expect to find all equipment in the good clean conditions that we left it in

*Any damage caused will incur cleaning /replacement charges accordingly

Additional information

SLIDES

Ensure only users of the same age and size range use the slide at any one time

Do not overload- observe the maximum number of users

Do not sit, climb on or slide down the safety wall

Do not jump or roll down the slide

Do not slide down head first –feet first only

Do not bounce on the top of the slide or run from side to side

Make sure the users at the bottom has vacated the landing area before commencing slide

We advise socks and long sleeves to be worn to reduce the possibilities of friction burns

SOFTPLAY

Ensure only users of the same age and size range use the equipment at any one time all users (including adult supervisors) to remove footwear before entering the play zone
